MOTION NO. 1514

A MOTION requesting the discontinuance of any legal action seeking revisionary rights on behalf of King County for property known as Sand Point.

WHEREAS, the King County Council had requested the Prosecuting Attorney to prepare a brief on possible ownership rights which King County might have to lands deeded to the Federal Government and now consisting of Sand Point Naval Air Station, and

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has submitted a report to the Council, after exhaustive study of the history of title transfers of the affected properties, which eliminates any question of possible reversionary rights, and


WHEREAS, it would not be in the public interest to proceed with litigation which might delay transfer of portions of Sand Point property to local agencies,

The King County Council respectfully requests the Prosecuting Attorney discontinue any further action in regards to the possibility of establishing reversionary rights to King County of the property known as Sand Point.
