

A MOTION proclaiming the week beginning May 1st as Youth Week.

1 WHEREAS, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks has
2 designated the week beginning May 1st, as Youth Week to honor
3 America's Junior Citizens for their accomplishments, and to give
4 fitting recognition of their services to Community, State and
5 Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800 will sponsor an observance
7 during that week in tribute to the Junior Citizens of this
8 Community; and

9 WHEREAS, no event could be more deserving of our support and
10 participation than one dedicated to these young people who rep-
11 resent the nation's greatest resource, and who in the years
12 ahead will assume the responsibility for the advancement of our
13 free society; and

14 WHEREAS, our Youth need the guidance, inspiration and encour-
15 agement which we can give in order to develop those qualities of
16 character essential for future leadership; and

17 WHEREAS, to achieve this worth objective we should demonstrate
18 our partnership with Youth, our understanding of their hopes and
19 aspirations and a sincere willingness to help prepare them in
20 every way for the responsibilities and opportunities of citizen-
21 ship;

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;

23 The King County Council hereby proclaims the week beginning
24 May 1st as Youth Week and urges all departments of government,
25 civic, fraternal and patriotic groups, and citizens generally, to
26 participate wholeheartedly in its observance.
