2 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to  
3 Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the  
4 U. S. Department of Health, Education and Wel-  
5 fare for Funds in the Amount of \$1,654,100 and  
6 to the State Office of Economic Opportunity for  
7 \$123,000 to Support the Seattle-King County  
8 Head Start Program.

9 WHEREAS, The Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, as amended,  
10 provides for the award of grants by the U.S. Department of Health,  
11 Education and Welfare, and,  
12

13 WHEREAS, The State Office of Economic Opportunity's Office  
14 of Child Development provides support for pre-school-age children  
15 educational programs, and  
16

17 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to provide  
18 assistance in the education and development of pre-school  
19 children residing in King County, and  
20

21 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide  
22 as support to this program approximately \$6,410 as an In-Kind  
23 contribution,

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to  
27 make application for funds in the amount of \$1,654,100 to the  
28 U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and the State  
29 Office of Economic Opportunity for \$123,000, on behalf of King  
30 County;

32 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and dir-  
33 ected to file and execute such application and contracts as are  
required by the State;


3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the  
authorized correspondent for King County and is further author-  
ized to furnish such additional information and documents as may  
be required by the State;

1           4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter  
2 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the im-  
3 plementation of the project.

4           5. That the United States of America, Department of Justice,  
5 and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance  
6 with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
