

1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to  
2 Execute and Submit Grant Applications to the  
3 Department of Health, Education and Welfare,  
4 and the LEAA, for the King County Youth Service  
5 Bureau System for Funds in the Amount of  
6 \$56,500 and \$145,833, Respectively.

7 WHEREAS, The Department of Health, Education and Welfare,  
8 and LEAA, provide funds for youth services to prevent delinquency  
9 and reduce recidivism, and

10 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to pro-  
11 vide comprehensive services for youth in an effort to prevent  
12 delinquency and reduce recidivism, and

13 WHEREAS, This grant would support a coordinated program  
14 to provide these services to youth, primarily with behavioral  
15 problems, and thus assist them in becoming good and useful cit-  
16 izens, and

17 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide  
18 as support to this program \$8,101, as a Cash Match,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King  
20 County:

21 1. The King County Executive is authorized to make ap-  
22 plication for funds in the amount of \$145,833 to LEAA, and  
23 \$56,500 to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, on  
24 behalf of King County;

25 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and  
26 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as  
27 are required by the State;

28 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named  
29 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further auth-  
30 orized to furnish such additional information and documents as  
31 may be required by the State;

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1           4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter  
2 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the im-  
3 plementation of the project.

4           5. That the United States of America, Department of  
5 Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full  
6 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

7           6. That the King County Council shall review the evalu-  
8 ation report prior to the allocation of the full grant funds for  
9 the second year of operation.
