A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration for Funds in the Amount of \$96,816 to Support the King County International Airport Crash-Fire-Rescue Building Project

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, is empowered to make grant awards for the construction and improvement of public airports, and

WHEREAS, The King County International Airport is in need of assistance for construction of a new crash-fire-rescue security building for emergency vehicles, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$25,000 as a cash match in support of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$96,816 to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration on behalf of King County;


2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Federal Aviation Administration;

3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Federal Aviation Administration;

4. The United States of America, Department of Transportation, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.


