A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice through the State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$53,100 and \$2,950 as a State buy-in to support an Education Program for Inmates of King County and Seattle Jails

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support the effort of the Seattle Central Community College to provide Inmates of the County and City of Seattle jails with the basic tools of education, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program approximately \$2,950 as a cash match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$53,100 to the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice through the State Law & Justice Planning Office and \$2,950 as a State buy-in on behalf of King County;
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
