1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
2 execute and submit a grant application to the
3 Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S.
4 Department of Justice through the State Law and
Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount
of \$53,100 and \$2,950 as a State buy-in to support
an Education Program for Inmates of King County
and Seattle Jails

5 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
6 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
7 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
8 through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

9 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support
10 the effort of the Seattle Central Community College to provide
11 Inmates of the County and City of Seattle jails with the basic
12 tools of education, and

13 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide
14 as support to this program approximately \$2,950 as a cash match.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
17 application for funds in the amount of \$53,100 to the Law Enforce-
18 ment Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice through
19 the State Law & Justice Planning Office and \$2,950 as a State
20 buy-in on behalf of King County;

21 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed
22 to file and execute such application and contracts as are required
23 by the State;

24 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authori-
25 zed correspondent for King County and is further authorized to
26 furnish such additional information and documents as may be re-
27 quired by the State;

28 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
29 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
30 implementation of the project;


