

MOTION NO. 1736

2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive  
3 to prepare the documents necessary to  
4 obtain bid proposals to design, construct,  
5 finance and operate concession facilities  
6 at the King County Stadium.

7 WHEREAS, on February 11, 1974 the Council unanimously  
8 adopted Motion No. 1440, endorsing the concept of competitive  
9 public bid for awarding the contract to operate and maintain the  
10 stadium concessions, and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Executive has presented to the  
12 Council for review and comments the performance specifications  
13 for the concessions,

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 The County Executive is hereby authorized to prepare the  
16 documents necessary to obtain bid proposals, pursuant to entering  
17 into a long-term contract to design, construct, finance and  
18 operate the concession facilities at the King County Domed  
19 Stadium.

20 The Council concurs with the Executive recommendation on the  
21 Performance Specification-Concessions with the following changes

22 1. The "Performance Specification-Concessions" outlines  
23 basic bid #1 and basic bid #2. Bidders are required to bid on at  
24 least one basic bid, with a bid on the other basic bid being  
25 optional.

26 2. In any or all cases, where the contract may require or  
27 permit action either by King County or the Stadium Manager, the  
28 King County Council reserves the right to assign to another  
29 individual or entity such required or permitted action.

30 3. To the Instructions to Bidders, Item 22, Non-Collusion,  
31 add the financing of any part of this contract will not be under-  
32 written in any way by a corporation, bank or other lending entity  
33 which has a controlling interest in or is a supplier of any item of  
food or drink or any other item that may be sold at a

1 concession stand pursuant to this contract at the King County  
2 Stadium.

3 4. Article 14 K - Fire Insurance and Extended Coverage -

4 In the event that the concession facilities are destroyed by  
5 perils insured against to the extent that continued operation is  
6 impractical or impossible, all proceeds of the insurance policy  
7 shall be paid to King County for all items except concessionaire  
8 owned equipment.

9 5. Article 25 - Price List - The price list as stated on


10 page 14 reflects a maximum price for each item and is offered  
11 for bidding purposes only. The actual prices to be charged,  
12 along with a proposed menu shall be approved in accordance with  
13 Article 24, of the concession operation contract.

14 BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

15 Before the final contract is signed by the County Executive,  
16 all bid proposals shall be presented to the County Council with a  
17 recommendation by the County Executive, for Council review and  
18 approval.


