WHEREAS, Judge Manolides has achieved much in the judicial field by extraordinary individual effort, and


WHEREAS, his years of service to the County of King, both as a deputy prosecuting attorney and as a judge have been of much benefit to its citizens,

PASSED this 15th day of October, 1974.


