A MOTION authorizing the sale of Tax Title Property to the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways, for and on behalf of the State of Washington, is authorized to purchase tax title property in accordance with the provisions of R.C.W. 84.64.320., and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington needs the tax title property for highway purposes, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has offered \$4,650.00 for the property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary instruments to convey the following described lands to the State of Washington:

All that portion of the following described Parcel "A" lying Southerly of a line described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence Northwest-erly to a point opposite Highway Engineer's Station (hereinafter referred to as H.E.S.) 156+00 and 310 feet Northerly when measured at right angles and/or radially to the centerline of SR 18 as shown on the plan of SR 167, Auburn: 17th Street SW to South 285th Street; thence Westerly parallel with said center-line to a point opposite H.E.S. 155+00; thence South-westerly to a point on the Southerly line of said Parcel "A" opposite H.E.S. 151+63.07 and 194.55 feet Northerly therefrom and the end of this line descrip-tion.

PARCEL "A"

Lots 73, 74, 75 and 76 of West Auburn Five Acre Tracts, as per plat recorded in Volume 15 of Plats on page 12, records of King County.
