

MOTION NO. 1798

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
2 execute and submit a grant application to the  
3 Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office  
4 for funds in the amount of \$90,000 to support the  
5 King County Subject in Process System Project

6 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of  
7 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
8 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice  
9 through the Washington State Law and Justice Office, and

10 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes the need to  
11 develop a Subject in Process Computer System that will provide  
12 tracking information on an adult from the time he enters the  
13 Criminal Justice System until final disposition, and

14 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as  
15 support to this program \$5,000 as cash match,

16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

17 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
18 application for funds in the amount of \$90,000 to the Washington  
19 State Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

20 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed  
21 to file and execute such application and contracts as are  
22 required by the State;

23 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the  
24 authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized  
25 to furnish such additional information and documents as may be  
26 required;

27 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into  
28 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implemen-  
29 tation of the project;  
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1 5. The United States of America, Department of Justice,  
2 and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance  
3 with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
