MOTION NO. 1808

A MOTION expressing support for joint participation by King County and suburban jurisdictions in an application for funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and outlining guidelines relative to planning and distribution of funds.

BE IT MOVED that the King County Council hereby expresses its support for joint participation by King County with eligible suburban jurisdictions in an application for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and acknowledges and encourages this precedent-setting opportunity for cooperative effort in behalf of county citizens.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED that the Council approves the following guidelines as a basis for joint planning and the distribution of funds:

- 1. A joint policy committee be established comprised of the county executive, two members of the council, and three elected representatives of the suburban jurisdictions, and said joint policy committee shall review and recommend all policy including allocation of funds.
- 2. The monies be divided into two funds, one designated for the county and the second for the incorporated areas, according to the monies brought to the fund based on population, poverty and overcrowding, provided that consideration be given in subsequent years to the advantages of pooling all monies into a single fund.
- 3. In determining the portions of monies attributable to population and need characteristics under 2. above, a minimum of fifty (50) percent of all monies be assigned to the two funds based on need.
- 4. The county utilize its funds for eligible activities by distributing:
- a. that portion of the monies brought to the fund based on population to the unincorporated area, and
