A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the United States Department of Labor through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium for funds in the amount of \$246,700 to support the King County Youth Corps Work and Training Program for Out of School Youth

WHEREAS, The Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended provides for the award of grants by the United States

- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Department of Labor;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
