

MOTION NO. 1840

A MOTION designating target areas for activities conducted under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

WHEREAS the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 provides for Block Grant funds to be awarded to urban counties, and

WHEREAS, the Act states that "the primary objective of the Community Development Program is the development of viable urban communities, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income.", and

WHEREAS, the Block Grant regulations require submission of an application containing a community development plan which must specify the "... general location" of Community Development activities, and,


WHEREAS, the application must also include maps indicating the "general location" of proposed activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED that the Council designate the following areas to satisfy these objectives and requirements:

1. White Center/North Burien
2. Snoqualmie Valley
3. Country Lane (in Federal Way)
4. Algona/Pacific
