

MOTION NO. 1841

2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive
3 to Execute and Submit a Grant Application to
4 the Department of Social and Health Services
5 for Funds in the Amount of \$270,000 to Support
6 the Contract Services Project - King County
7 Adult Probation Subsidy Plan.

8 WHEREAS, The Adult Probation Subsidy Act provides for the
9 award of grants by the Department of Social and Health Services
10 to counties, to increase local rehabilitative resources, and

11 WHEREAS, the County recognizes the need to reduce the re-
12 conviction rate and develop local resources for probationers, to
13 reduce the need for institutional commitment,

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
16 to make application to the Department of Social and Health
17 Services for funds in the amount of \$270,000 on behalf of King
18 County;

19 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
20 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
21 are required by the State;

22 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
23 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
24 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
25 as may be required by the State;

26 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
27 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
28 implementation of the project.

1 5. That the United States of America, Department of
2 Social and Health Services, and the State of Washington are here-
3 by assured full compliance with Title VII of the Civil Rights Act
4 of 1964.

5 6. Following official notification of grant award and
6 prior to the beginning of planned activities; the Executive shall
7 notify the Chairman of the Operations and Judiciary Committee, in
8 writing, of any substantive changes in the approved document
9 necessitated by funding source review. The Operations and
10 Judiciary Committee shall then prepare a motion authorizing said
11 program changes.

12 7. No funds shall be appropriated for any planned
13 activity unless the proposed appropriation is accompanied by a
14 "Memorandum of Agreement", prepared by the Executive. The
15 "Memorandum of Agreement" shall clearly and concisely state the
16 quantitative objectives of the planned activity. The agreement
17 shall state the means and methods to be used, including time
18 frames, in evaluating the ability of the program sponsor to
19 accomplish stated objectives.


