A MOTION authorizing King County's Housing and Community Development activities to be included in the 1975 Block Grant application process.

WHEREAS King County's "Urban County" arrangement requires that a governing body validate and prioritize all project proposals which its jurisdiction desires to undertake with Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS King County receives \$543,000 in "population monies" for the 1975 program year which it can allocate consistent with the King County Community Development Objectives, and

WHEREAS, to receive additional Block Grant monies for the 1975 program year, King County must submit additional project proposals to be considered with proposals from other participating jurisdictions for funding based on need,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the King County Council that the following projects are to be included in the 1975 action year program to be funded out of the County's "population monies":
