2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 execute and submit a grant application to the
4 Department of Health, Education and Welfare,
5 Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health
Administration for funds in the amount of
\$1,337,479 to support the Center for
Addiction Services Project.

6 WHEREAS, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare,
7 Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Administration, awards
8 grants to provide valid alternatives to incarceration for the
9 serious drug user through a wide range of individualized programs;
10 provides funds to develop and facilitate a comprehensive,
11 cohesive program through existing agencies; provides funds for
12 diagnostic detoxification, methadone maintenance and residential
13 services as well as outpatient counseling, referral, and follow
14 up services to facilitate rehabilitation, and

15 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide, as
16 support to this program, \$12,500 as a local cash match,

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
19 application to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare,
20 Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Administration, on behalf
21 of King County, for funds in the amount of \$1,337,479 to support
22 the Center for Addiction Services Project;

23 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed
24 to file and execute such application and contracts as are
25 required by the federal government;

26 3. The Intergovernmental Relations Division is named the
27 authorized correspondent for King County and is further
28 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
29 as may be required by the federal government;

30 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into
31 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implemen-
32 tation of the project;

a. A projected budget for the Center for Addiction Services for the year following the termination of the present grant from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare; and

b. A projection of essential services to be delivered by the Center for Addiction Services in the year following the termination of the present grant from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare; and

c. A statement of measurable program goals and objectives for the Center for Addiction Services; and

d. A mechanism for periodic reporting and reviewing of the Center for Addiction Services activities;



