1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to
2 Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the
3 State Law and Justice Planning Office for Funds
4 in the Amount of \$26,028.03 to Enable the King
5 County Department of Public Safety to Purchase
6 Color Video Equipment Under a GSA-LEAA Bid to
7 Improve Training Capability of the Department,
8 King County File No. 510

9 WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
12 through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to improve
14 the training capability of the Department of Public Safety, and

15 WHEREAS, The County Council finds that an improved training
16 capability is in the best interest of the general public and will
17 provide greater protection and safety to the general public, and

18 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide
19 approximately \$2,892 in a cash match for support of this project,

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

21 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
22 application for funds in the amount of \$28,920.03 to the State
23 Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

24 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed
25 to file and execute such application and contracts as are required
26 by the State;

27 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the
28 authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized
29 to furnish such additional information and documents as may be
30 required by the State;

31 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into
32 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implemen-
33 tation of the project.
