WHEREAS, King County as a member of the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium ascribes to and supports the setting of service level goals to insure adequate employment opportunities

WHEREAS, King County acknowledges its responsibility to serve unemployed groups, defined as service level goals by the Consortium, defined on the basis of age, sex, ethnic race, income levels, and

to those groups historically barred equitable entrance into fields

WHEREAS, King County is desirious of increasing job opportunities for the unemployed by insuring that employment opportunities in the form of employment positions are created within a geographic proximity to specific unemployed groups, and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the statistical accomplishment of service level goals may be restricting the filling of previously approved CETA positions due to the lack of service goal qualified CETA applicatns, residing in an area in close proximity to proposed CETA positions' work stations, thereby creating a transportation hardship to be borne by CETA applicants desirous of filling created positions,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL:

- 1. The Executive is directed to insure that CETA positions can be filled by the unemployed located in close geographical proximity to the proposed work station where CETA positions will perform work;
