1 A MOTION relating to the County's participation  
2 in the CETA program; directing the Executive to  
3 perform certain activities.

4 WHEREAS, King County as a member of the King-Snohomish  
5 Manpower Consortium ascribes to and supports the setting of  
6 service level goals to insure adequate employment opportunities  
7 to those groups historically barred equitable entrance into fields  
8 of employment, and

9 WHEREAS, King County acknowledges its responsibility to  
10 serve unemployed groups, defined as service level goals by the  
11 Consortium, defined on the basis of age, sex, ethnic race, income  
12 levels, and

13 WHEREAS, King County is desirous of increasing job oppor-  
14 tunities for the unemployed by insuring that employment oppor-  
15 tunities in the form of employment positions are created within  
16 a geographic proximity to specific unemployed groups, and

17 WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the statistical  
18 accomplishment of service level goals may be restricting the  
19 filling of ~~previously~~ approved CETA positions due to the lack of  
20 service goal qualified CETA applicatns, residing in an area in  
21 close proximity to proposed CETA positions' work stations, thereby  
22 creating a transportation hardship to be borne by CETA applicants  
23 desirous of filling created positions,

24 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL:

25 1. The Executive is directed to insure that CETA positions  
26 can be filled by the unemployed located in close geographical  
27 proximity to the proposed work station where CETA positions will  
28 perform work;
