

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Washington State Heart Association for funds in the amount of \$6,000 to support an investigation by the Office of the Medical Examiner into injuries and complications resulting from cardiopulmonary resuscitation

WHEREAS, the Washington State Heart Association is empowered to make grant awards for the purposes of cardiovascular research, and

WHEREAS, the King County Office of the Medical Examiner plans to undertake an investigation into the character, extent and nature of cardiopulmonary resuscitation injuries and is in need of assistance in order to purchase necessary equipment, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$7,776 as an inkind share in support of this project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$6,000 to the Washington State Heart Association on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Washington State Heart Association;

3. The Intergovernmental Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Washington State Heart Association;

4. The United States of America, Department of Transportation, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
