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A MOTION relating to a request to the Executive to submit a report to the County Council on all possible revenue sources for a Paramedic/Mobile Intensive Care Unit Program.

WHEREAS, the Council of King County is considering means of implementing a Paramedic/Mobile Intensive Care Unit Program for the County, and

WHEREAS, the amount of revenue available for such a program is essential to any discussion of implementation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is requested to submit a report to the County Council on all possible revenue sources for a Paramedic/Mobile Intensive Care Unit Program. Such a report shall include, but not be limited to, the following sources:

1. A Countywide utility tax;
2. A special levy, either Countywide or through some other taxing authority;
3. User's fees;
4. Excess tuberculosis millage;
5. Public Health pooling fund;
6. General County revenues.
