WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District for the conversion of existing overhead wiring to underground wiring and the erection of ornamental street lights in the streets of a portion of the plat of No-Ko-Mis Park. The petition stipulated an estimated assessment of \$950 per buildable site and requested that the payments for this improvement be made by special assessment payable in fifteen equal annual installments.

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on February 10, 1975, referred the above said petition to the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, said Director has contacted Seattle City Light and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company, and they have established a boundary that is feasible for the improvement district, and

WHEREAS, said Director also contacted TelePrompter of Seattle CATV, and was informed that all property owners are on CATV and that a CATV cost of \$65 should be added to the \$950 per buildable site cost, and

WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation, has certified that said petition has been signed by owners of 64 percent of the lineal front footage upon the proposed improvement and 51 per cent of the area within the boundary of the proposed improvement district,
