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2 A MOTION designating Community Development
3 Block Grant Target Areas for the 1976 program
4 year and directing the Division of Land Use
5 Management to include Housing and Community
6 Development in its Community Plans.

7 WHEREAS, King County will be receiving nearly \$3.3 million
8 in Community Development Block Grant funds for the 1976 program
9 year, an increase of more than \$1.5 million over 1975, and

10 WHEREAS, it is important that the Housing and Community
11 Development program be coordinated with other County programs,
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the designation of Community Development Target
14 Areas provides the focus for concentrated actions, especially to
15 aid people of low and moderate income, and

16 WHEREAS, all appropriate areas of the unincorporated County
17 were reviewed for possible target area designation for 1976,
18 based on the same criteria as 1975 target area selection, and

19 WHEREAS, community meetings and a Council hearing have been
20 held on new target area selections for the 1976 program year,

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 That the following are designated as Community Development
23 Target Areas for the 1976 program year:

- 24 (1) White Center - see attachment for boundaries
25 (2) Snoqualmie Valley - see attachment for boundaries
26 (3) Vashon Island - see attachment for boundaries
27 (4) Maple Valley - see attachment for boundaries
28 (5) South Central - see attachment for boundaries

29 BE IT FURTHER MOVED that, beginning with the Northshore and
30 Highline Community Plans, the Division of Land Use Management is
31 directed to make Housing and Community Development part of all
32 community plans prepared by the Division, and

1 BE IT FURTHER MOVED that Housing and Community Development
2 planning for the Kenmore/North Woodinville area be included in
3 the Northshore Community Plan.

4 BE IT FURTHER MOVED that the Housing and Community Development
5 staff be directed to develop a plan for using discretionary funds
6 in pocket areas of the County which social, economic, and
7 environmental indicators show as problem areas but which, when
8 considered as part of a larger community, do not meet the target
9 area criteria.

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PROPOSED TARGET AREA BOUNDARIESMAPLE VALLEY

Census Tract 320 west of 280th Avenue Southeast and including the southern portion of the Tahoma School District west of 280th Avenue Southeast and south of Census Tract 320.

SOUTH CENTRAL

South of Seattle City Light Transmission Line (approximately South 112th Street) west of I-5, east of Pacific Highway South and north of South 144th Street, excluding the portion of Tukwila in Census Tract 272.

VASHON ISLAND

WHITE CENTER ADDITION

The boundaries of the White Center target area, amended to include the Burien Heights Elementary School located at 1210 Southwest 136th Street immediately west of Ambaum Boulevard.

SNOQUALMIE VALLEY ADDITION

The boundaries of the Snoqualmie Valley target area, amended to include the floor of the Raging River Valley including the Community of Preston.
