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MOTION NO. 2118

A MOTION declaring the intent to form a Road Improvement District for underground wiring to be designated Sheridan No. 5.

WHEREAS, two petitions have been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District for the conversion of existing overhead wiring to underground wiring and the erection of ornamental street lights. One petition bears a cost estimate of \$950 per buildable site. The second petition bears a cost estimate of \$240 per buildable site for an area along 36th Avenue NE which has wiring presently underground and is intended primarily for the erection of ornamental street lights.

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on April 30, 1975, referred the above said petitions to the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, said Director has contacted Seattle City Light and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company, and they have established a boundary that is feasible for the improvement district, and

WHEREAS, said Director also contacted Cablevision CATV, and was informed that many property owners are on CATV and that a CATV cost of \$65 should be added to the \$950 per buildable site cost, and

WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation, has certified that said petition has been signed by owners of 64 percent of the lineal front footage upon the proposed improvement and 64 percent of the area within the boundary of the proposed improvement district,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.020, 36.88.050, and 36.88.410, it is the intention of the County Council of King County, Washington, to order the improvement of

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the streets and avenues described within this Motion by the conversion of existing overhead electric and communication facilities to underground facilities and the conversion of existing street lighting facilities to ornamental street lighting facilities, to be served from underground electrical facilities.

- The total cost and expense to the benefiting property owners is estimated to be \$107,550. This estimate is based on 101 buildable sites at \$1,015 per site which includes \$65 per site for cable television and 19 buildable sites at \$240 per site and one lot receiving partial benefit estimated to be \$475. The number of buildable sites has been estimated by King County Department of Public Works and Transportation, Seattle City Light, and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company. Property owners constructing future dwellings above the number estimated and as stated in this King County Motion will be required to pay to Seattle City Light the full "per buildable site" fee prior to being furnished electrical service to the future dwelling. total cost and expense of this improvement will be borne by the benefited property owners and Seattle City Light.
- It is the intention of the King County Council to establish a road improvement district to be known and designated as King County Road Improvement District No. 69, which said district shall include all of the following property and streets and avenues described herein:

Beginning at the NE corner of the plat of Sheridan Manor (75-11); thence South along the East line of said plat and its Southerly extension to the North line of Sherwood Glen (64-83); thence West along said North line to the NE corner of Lot 10 of Sherwood Glen; thence South along the East Line of Lots 10, 9, 8, 7 and 6 to the SE corner of said Lot 6 which is also a point on the North line of Lot 8 Jensen's Lake Vue Addition (82-22); thence East along said North line to the NE corner of Lot 8; thence South along

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the East line of Lots 8, 7 and 6 to the SE corner of said Lot 6; thence West along the South line of Lot 6 to the NE corner of Lot 2, Block 2 Stonacks Lake Vue Terrace (49-51); thence South along the East line of lot 2 to the NW corner of Lot 10, Block 2 of said plat; thence East along the North line of Lot 10 to the West right of way margin of 37th Avenue NE; thence SE'ly across 37th Avenue NE to the NW corner of Lot 12, Block 4 of said plat; thence East along the North line of Lot 12 to the West right of way margin of 38th Avenue NE; thence South along said West margin to its intersection with the West right of way margin of Bothell Way NE; thence Southerly along said West margin to the North right of way margin of NE 155th Street; thence Westerly along said North margin to the East right of way margin of 35th Avenue NE; thence NW'ly across 35th Avenue NE to the SE corner of Lot 3, Block 15 of State Plat in Section 16 as recorded in Volume 42 of Plats pages 10 and 11; thence West along the South line of Lot 3 to the SW corner thereof; thence North along the West line of Lots 3 and 2 to the South line of Lot 1; thence East along the South line of Lot 1 to a line 100 feet West of and parallel to the East line of said Lot 1; thence North along said parallel line and its Northerly extension to the South line of Lot 3 Block 14 of said State Plat; thence East to a line parallel to and 75 feet East of the West line of Lot 3; thence North along said parallel line to the South line of Lot 2; thence West along said South line to the SW corner of Lot 2; thence North along the West line of Lots 2 and 1 and continuing in a straight line along the West line of Lots 7 through 2 of Block 7 said State Plat to the South line of Lot 1; thence East to a line 37 feet East of and parallel to the West line of Lot 1; thence North along said parallel line and its Northerly extension. to the South line of Lot 7 Block 6 of said State Plat;

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thence West to the SW corner of said Lot 7; thence North along the centerline of Block 6 and continuing North along the centerline of Block 1 to the North line of Lot 4 of Block 1; thence East along said North line and its Easterly extension to the centerline of NE 162nd Street; thence SE'ly along said centerline to the Northerly extension of the East line of the plat of Sheridan Manor; thence South along said extension to the NE corner of said plat and the point of beginning.

- 4. All persons who may desire to object to the aforesaid improvement/assessment district are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the King County Council to be held in Room 402 King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m., on 6% day of October , 1975, which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing of matters relating to said proposed improvements and all objections thereto, and for confirming the method of payment as petitioned for this improvement.
- 5. The Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation is hereby directed to submit to the King County Council at or prior to the date fixed for such hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the lots and other property which will be specially benefited thereby and the estimated amount of cost and expense of such improvement to be borne by each buildable site.
- 6. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of said hearing by publication of this motion in at least two consecutive issues of a newspaper of general circulation in King County, with the date of the first publication to be at least fifteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and to mail a notice of said hearing to the owners or reputed owners of property in the proposed assessment district, as shown on the tax rolls of the King County Office of Comptroller at the address shown thereon, at least fifteen days prior to said hearing. The

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notice shall refer to the Motion of Intention and designate the proposed improvement district by number. The notice shall also set forth the nature of the proposed improvement, the total estimated cost, the portion of the total cost to be borne by assessments, the estimated amount of the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by the particular lot, tract, or parcel, the date and place of the hearing before the County Council, and the fact that the property owners may withdraw their names from the petition or add their names thereto at any time prior to 4:30 p.m. on the day before the hearing.
