MOTION NO. 2161

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A MOTION declaring the intention to form a Road Improvement District to improve 38th Avenue South from South 380th Street to Military Road to be known as King County Road Improvement District No. 71

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District to improve 38th Avenue South from South 380th Street northerly to Military Road.

The petition requests that payments for the improvement be made by special assessment payable in fifteen (15) equal annual installments, under mode of payment by bond, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on April 18, 1975, referred the above petition to the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of 55 percent of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made and 54 percent of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created, and that the improvement appears to be feasible and the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: <u>SECTION 1</u>: Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.010, 36.88.020, and 36.88.050, it is the intention of the King County Council to order the improvement of 38th Avenue South from South 380th Street northerly for approximately one-half mile to an intersection with Military Road.

SECTION 2: The estimated cost and expense of this improvement is \$72,066.24. It is the intention that 25% of the total cost and expense of the improvement shall be borne by King County. The remaining 75% of the cost and expense shall be borne by the owners of private property within the proposed improvement district. It is the intention that assessments shall be based on front footage on the improvement, and shall be paid over a period of 15 years.

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SECTION 3: It is the intention of the King County Council to form a road improvement district to be known and designated as King County Road Improvement District No. 71. The assessment district shall include all of the private property lying within strips of land 120 feet wide lying parallel with and adjacent to the east and west right of way margins of 38th Avenue South, and lying northerly of South 380th Street and southerly of South 372nd Street.

SECTION 4: All persons who may desire to object to the construction of the aforesaid improvement or the formation of the aforesaid assessment district are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the King County Council, to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse in the City of Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the $27\frac{d}{d}$ day of October, 1975, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing of matters relating to said proposed improvements, and all objections thereto.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation is hereby directed to submit to the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other property which will be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated amount of cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all property which is being purchased under contract from the County.

SECTION 6: The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of said hearing by publication of this motion in at least two consecutive issues of a newspaper of general circulation in King County, with the date of first

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publication to be at least fifteen days prior to the date of said 1 hearing, and to mail a notice of said hearing to the owners or 2 reputed owners of property in the proposed assessment district, 3 as shown on the tax rolls of the King County Office of Comptroller at the address shown thereon, at least fifteen days prior to said 5 The notice shall refer to the Motion of Intention and 6 hearing. designate the proposed improvement district by number.
