A MOTION authorizing additional positions under the Public Employment Program.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2469 appropriates \$1,957,004 to the fiscal year 1975-76 CETA Title II Fund, and \$4,514,237 to the new CETA Title VI Fund, and

WHEREAS, King County is eligible to receive CETA funds to hire eligible King County residents in appropriate positions, and


WHEREAS, the Council of King County recognizes the need to provide employment for King County residents.
