

MOTION NO. 2237

1 A MOTION increasing the amount of estimated
2 revenues in the 1976 County Budget.

3 WHEREAS, the 1976 Executive Proposed Budget for King County
4 including estimated revenues and other resources to finance the
5 operation of the County and its capital expenditures during 1976,
6 and

7 WHEREAS, the factors influencing revenue receipts of the
8 County are subject to change and the estimates themselves subject
9 to refinement, and

10 WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed the 1976 revenue
11 estimates as proposed by the Executive in light of changing con-
12 ditions during its 1976 budget deliberations, and

13 WHEREAS, the Executive has requested a revision to the
14 estimated gas tax receipts, and

15 WHEREAS, increases in estimated revenues must be adopted by
16 motion of the Council passed by six affirmative votes,

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 The estimated revenues contained in the Executive proposed
19 1976 budget are revised to include the following increases:
