2 A MOTION endorsing a proposed interlocal
3 agreement for a regional and subregional
4 planning organization to replace the
5 Puget Sound Council of Governments.

6 WHEREAS, the counties of King, Pierce and Snohomish desire
7 to establish and participate in a planning organization that
8 satisfies both the metropolitan transportation and A-95
9 requirements of the Federal Government; and

10 WHEREAS, the counties of King, Pierce and Snohomish also
11 desire to establish and participate in a planning organization
12 that allows local elected officials to realistically address
13 and resolve interjurisdictional issues of greater than local
14 concern; and

15 WHEREAS, no viable organization can exist to carry out these
16 purposes without the active support and participation of the
17 cities and towns of the Central Puget Sound Region; and

18 WHEREAS, the counties of King, Pierce and Snohomish have
19 jointly developed a proposal for an organization that reflects a
20 consensus of their respective viewpoints.

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 That a proposed interlocal agreement for a regional and
23 subregional planning organization to replace the Puget Sound
24 Council of Governments is hereby endorsed in concept as a more
25 efficient and economic means of satisfying both federal
26 transportation requirements and the needs of local government.
