

MOTION NO. 2279

A MOTION recognizing the continuing world hunger crisis and supporting Project Tahoua.

WHEREAS, the King County Council in Motion #1811 declared Tahoua, Niger to be King County's Sister County; and

WHEREAS, in 1974 County employees and interested citizens contributed \$4,195 to CARE for aid to Tahoua; and

WHEREAS, this assistance enabled Tahouans to minimize starvation and begin to rebuild their community; and

WHEREAS, further assistance is needed to enable continued progress in Tahoua; and

WHEREAS, the second Project Tahoua campaign will commence on January 20.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. County employees are encouraged to support Project Tahoua so that they might acquaint themselves with the world food crisis and contribute to CARE's humanitarian work in Niger;

2. The King County Council encourages other units of government and citizens of King County and the State of Washington to join in the effort to aid the people of Niger and its neighboring countries.
