A MOTION granting the City of Seattle an easement for a watermain within the Lake Washington - Seattle North Trail in King County.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle, a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, has made application for the right to construct and maintain a watermain with appurtenant hydrants and connections within the hereinafter described property of King County, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals the watermain would benefit the citizens of King County residing in the vicinity of the proposed route, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that it would be to the County's advantage and in the best interests of the citizens of King County and the City of Seattle that the said easement be granted, for and in consideration of mutual benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary agreement granting the City of Seattle the easement over, under, across and along the following described property situated in King County, State of Washington:

A strip of land 6 feet in width with a centerline two (2) feet westerly of and parallel to the centerline of the trail right of way existing in that portion of the Lake Washington - Seattle North Trail (Burke-Gilman Trail) lying between N.E. 145th Street and N.E. 160th Street, as acquired by the County from Burlington Northern, Inc. on June 1, 1974, under recording No. 7406100492.

Together with eight (8) areas ten (10) feet wide extending three (3) feet beyond the center point of the water hydrants to be installed as approved by the County and in locations approved by the County.
