

MOTION NO. 2318

2 A MOTION directing the King County Department
3 of Stadium Administration to make a survey
4 for a study of the use of school buses to
5 facilitate stadium traffic for those
6 occasions when the stadium is in full use.

7 WHEREAS, King County has contracted the King Dome Stadium
8 and it is their desire to see that it is utilized to the fullest
9 extent possible; and

10 WHEREAS, it is projected by the King County Department of
11 Stadium Administration, based upon the studies of stadium usage,
12 that there will be capacity crowds from 55,000 to 67,000 persons
13 approximately 18 times a year; and

14 WHEREAS, the projected parking for both Metro transit and
15 private automobiles will necessitate many of the patrons of
16 those big events walking as far as a mile and a quarter to
17 attend said events; and

18 WHEREAS, all of the projections for the stadium usage on
19 these maximum events indicate that there will be extreme traffic
20 congestion on the freeway and other routes servicing that
21 facility; and

22 WHEREAS, there is not enough parking on the stadium site to
23 facilitate those who intend to attend the functions on those
24 days of maximum use; and

25 WHEREAS, there is a source of transportation, namely,
26 school buses, that could relieve the congestion and could
27 handle all or any part of those desiring to attend stadium
28 functions, and could be parked on the stadium site - all at a
29 lesser cost than the use of private automobiles or even Metro
30 coaches;


31 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
32 That the Department of Stadium Administration be instructed to
33

1 make a survey of the available school bus facilities, parking
2 on the site, routing and other facets of the possible use of
3 school buses to relieve the traffic and/or parking congestion
4 at the King Dome Stadium.

5 AND BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County
6 that the said Department of Stadium Administration be instructed
7 to report back their findings to the King County Council within
8 30 days from the date of this Motion.
