A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the United States Civil Service Commission for funds in the amount of \$13,900 to support the Part-time Careers for Men and Women in Public Service - Feasibility and Implications Program.

WHEREAS, the United States Civil Service Commission provides for the award of grants for personnel administration improvements, and

WHEREAS, the County desires to improve the operation of the personnel system by making possible more flexible employment conditions for County employees, and

WHEREAS, The University of Washington is willing to provide an in-kind contribution of \$4,300 in supportive services to King County, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide \$8,600 as in-kind contribution and \$1,000 in cash as support to this program,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$13,900 to the United States Civil Service Commission on behalf of King County, to support the Part-time Careers for Men and Women in Public Service-Feasibility and Implications Program, Grant File #604.
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Federal Government;
