2 A MOTION authorizing application to the Depart-
3 ment of the Interior Bureau of Outdoor Recreation
4 for Federal Surplus Property on Vashon Island
5 for a Public Park.

6 WHEREAS, certain real property owned by the United States,
7 located in the County of King, State of Washington, has been
8 declared surplus and at the discretion of the General Services
9 Administration, may be assigned to the Secretary of the Interior
10 for disposal for public park or recreation purposes, under the
11 provisions of Section 203(k)(2) of the Federal Property and
12 Administrative Services Act of 1949 (63 Stat. 387), as amended,
13 and rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, and

14 WHEREAS, King County, Washington will utilize said pro-
15 perty in perpetuity for a public park or recreation area as
16 set forth in its application and in accordance with the require-
17 ments of said Act and the rules and regulations promulgated
18 thereunder,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
20 King County, Washington shall make application to the Secre-
21 tary of the Interior for and secure the transfer to it of the
22 property described as follows:

23 Seattle Defense Area Nike Site No.61
24 Vashon Island
25 G.S.A. Control No. D-WASH-562A
26 Launch Site 43.09+ Acres

27 for use as a public park or recreation area upon and subject to
28 such exceptions, reservations, terms, covenants, agreements,
29 conditions and restrictions as the Secretary of the Interior,
30 or his authorized representative, may require in connection
31 with the disposal of said property under said Act and the rules
32 and regulations issued pursuant thereto;

33 BE IT FURTHER MOVED: King County has legal authority, is
willing and is in a position to assume immediate care and main-
tenance of the property, and that John D. Spellman, King County

1 Executive, be and he is authorized, for and on behalf of King
 2 County to do and perform any and all acts and things which may
 3 be necessary to carry out the foregoing Motion including the
 4 preparing, making and filing of plans, applications, reports
 5 and other documents, the execution, acceptance, delivery, and
 6 recording of agreements, deeds and other instruments pertaining
 7 to the transfer of said property, including the filing of copies
 8 of the application and the conveyance documents in the records
 9 of the governing body, and the payment of any and all sums
 10 necessary on account of the purchase price thereof or fees or
 11 costs incurred in connection with the transfer of said property
 12 for survey, title searches, recording of instruments, or other
 13 costs identified with the Federal surplus property acquisition.
