

MOTION NO. 2444

1 A MOTION granting an easement in favor of King
2 County Water District No. 90 over Cedar River
3 Park.

4 WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 90, a municipal
5 corporation of King County, Washington, has made application
6 for the right to construct and maintain a sewer trunk line
7 and a water line under and across a strip of land which is a
8 portion of Cedar River Park, and

9 WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the
10 County's advantage to grant to Water District No. 90 the
11 easement described herein, and

12 WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best
13 interests of the citizens of King County that the said ease-
14 ment be granted in and for the consideration of mutual bene-
15 fits, together with the right of King County to make two
16 side sewer connections, which right will offset the value
17 placed upon the easement requested by the District,

18 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver
20 the necessary sewer and water line agreement, granting to
21 Water District No. 90 the easement described as follows:

22 A strip of land, 15 feet in width, parallel
23 to and contiguous with the Burlington North-
24 ern Railway Right of Way, on and across the
25 following described parcels:

26 That portion of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of
27 Section 22, Township 23 North, Range 5 East,
28 W.M., lying Easterly of the Cedar River and
29 Northerly of the Burlington Northern Rail-
30 way Right of Way, (being a portion of Gov-
31 ernment Lot 10 and of the abandoned bed of
32 the Cedar River);


33 Portion of Government Lots 3 and 8 in Sec-

Northern Railway Right of Way.


