

MOTION NO. 2474

2 A MOTION adopting the 1977 King County Law
3 and Justice Plan, and authorizing the County
4 Executive to submit the Plan and formal grant
5 applications for all 1977 King County projects
6 contained therein to the Washington State
7 Office of Community Development, Law and
8 Justice Planning Office.

9 WHEREAS, the State of Washington's Law and Justice Planning
10 Office and the Governor's Committee on Law and Justice require
11 that a regional plan be prepared and adopted by King County as an
12 anticipated condition of King County's eligibility for the receipt
13 of block grant funds made available to local governments under the
14 anticipated provisions of a new Crime Control Act of 1977, and

15 WHEREAS, the State Law and Justice Planning Office has
16 tentatively reserved 1977 Part "C" block grant funds for local
17 regions on the basis of a formula, and

18 WHEREAS, the 1977 King County Law and Justice Plan and
19 project funding recommended by the King County Law and Justice
20 Planning Committee best meets the needs of King County and
21 participating suburban city governments given the fiscal
22 constraint of an estimated \$620,000 to \$650,000 FY 1977 funds
23 available to King County,

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 1. The King County Council hereby approves and adopts the
26 1977 King County Law and Justice Plan and authorizes the County
27 Executive to submit said Plan and to submit formal grant
28 applications for all King County projects contained therein to
29 the Washington State Office of Community Development, Law and
30 Justice Planning Office.

31 2. Following official notification of grant award and prior
32 to the beginning of planned activities, the Executive shall notify
33 the Chairman of the Council, in writing, of any substantive
34 changes in the approved document necessitated by funding source
35 review. The Operations, Police and Judiciary Committee shall then
36 discuss substantive changes in the plan and, if deemed necessary,

prepare a motion for Council approval authorizing program changes.

3. No funds shall be appropriated for any planned activity unless the proposed appropriation is accompanied by a letter from the project director. The letter shall clearly and concisely state the objectives of the planned activity.

4. The proposed expansion of the King County work release program shall not be implemented:


A. Unless DSHS agrees that in any proposed contractual arrangement the county retains the right to select the future site and contractor of the proposed work release facility, and

B. The future site and contractor of the proposed work release facility is approved by motion of the Council.


5. The Executive shall provide the Council with a plan detailing maintenance requirements and costs for the Public Safety Department's completed radio communications program in conjunction with the submission of the 1977 County operating budget.
