A MOTION granting an easement in favor of King County Water District No. 19 over John Ober Memorial Park.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 19, a municipal corporation of King County, Washington, has made application for the right to construct and maintain an 8" water line under and across a strip of land which is a portion of John Ober Memorial Park, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the County's advantage to grant to Water District No. 19 the easement described herein for the consideration of mutual benefits, and the right to make one water connection into water line, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement be granted,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary water line agreement, granting to Water District No. 19 the easement described as follows:

10 Foot Permanent Easement: The South 10 ft. of the North 165 ft. of the West 288.7 ft. of the West 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, EXCEPT the West 30 ft. thereof.

10 Foot Temporary Construction Easement: The North 10 ft. of the South 20 ft. of the North 165 ft. of the West 288.7 ft. of the West 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, EXCEPT the West 30 ft. thereof.
