

MOTION NO. 2513

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A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner regarding the Proposed Plat of FIRSTMARK ADDITION NO. 4, designated Building and Land Development File No. 476-14, and adding a condition thereto.

WHEREAS, the Proposed Plat of FIRSTMARK ADDITION NO. 4, designated Building and Land Development File No. 476-14, was approved by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on April 13, 1976, subject to conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Washington School District #414 has appealed to the King County Council to add a condition which will encourage a pedestrian walkway along the Inglewood Hill Road by requiring the developer of the plat to construct a pedestrian walkway along the south boundary of his plat; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has under consideration a motion which will require such a facility in similar instances, and concurs with the need for such a facility along the Inglewood Hill Road,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Proposed Plat of FIRSTMARK ADDITION NO. 4, designated Building and Land Development File No. 476-14, is approved subject to the conditions recommended by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in his report dated April 13, 1976 and subject to the following additional condition:


Condition 5(g) to read:

An all-weather pedestrian walkway shall be required along Inglewood Hill Road. The location, width and

material used in this pathway shall be subject to approval by the Department of Public Works.
