A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to transmit a Letter of Intent to sponsor the Green-Duwamish River Levee Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, today the Green River Valley is a unique natural resource providing substantial agricultural, recreation, open space and industrial benefits to the Central Puget Sound Region, and,

WHEREAS, since the 1950's King County, in collaboration with the affected local governments, has exercised continuing responsibility for flood control and mitigation in the Green River Valley, and

WHEREAS, in 1965, due to increased flowage requirements made necessary by the SCS Drainage Project, King County requested the Corps of Engineers to study the alternatives available to expand the channel capacity of the Green and Duwamish Rivers, and

WHEREAS, in 1971, after preliminary alternatives had been identified by the Corps, King County requested that the study be expanded to include green belts, parks and trails, thereby providing a joint flood control/recreation development project along the Green and Duwamish Rivers between Allentown and Auburn, and

WHEREAS, in 1971 the Corps of Engineers suspended their study until such a plan could be developed by the County and the Valley cities, and

WHEREAS, the Green/Duwamish Levee Project represents a viable approach to providing flood and drainage protection to the residents and property owners of the Valley while ensuring to the fullest extent possible that the agriculture and recreation benefits of the Valley can be preserved, and

WHEREAS, in January 1976, by Motion 2282 the County Council requested the County Executive to determine the most effective means to implement the Corps' project, and

WHEREAS, the Corps of Engineers has requested further correspondence indicating the County's intent to sponsor the levee project before requesting Congressional authorization and commencing additional studies necessary to implement the Levee Project,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The County Executive is hereby authorized to transmit to the Seattle District, Corps of Engineers, a letter of intent indicating King County's willingness to sponsor the Green/ Duwamish River Levee Improvement Project.

Before establishing the final scope of the project, the County Executive is authorized to give special consideration to the feasibility of set-back levees to permit the development of a Green River Parkway, and is requested to develop a riverside recreation plan as a part of levee improvement studies.
