

MOTION NO. 2011

A MOTION requesting the Washington State Highway Commission to take whatever steps necessary to authorize construction of an access to Highway SR 522 in the vicinity of NE 190th Street in the Woodinville-Bothell area.

WHEREAS, the Woodinville area is one of the fastest growing areas of the State, and

WHEREAS, the Northshore Community Planning activity has been treating the circulation aspect of the Woodinville area's development in the citizens - County planning effort, and

WHEREAS, Policy 8 A of the Proposed Northshore Community Plan advocates a by-pass of the present central business district of Woodinville between I-405 and the Woodinville-Duvall Road in the vicinity of NE 195th Street to alleviate congestion on NE 175th Street and to provide better access to the growing industrial and residential areas of Woodinville, and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


