MOTION NO.

A MOTION relating to the operation and administration of the Seattle-King County Health Department and finding that King County and the City of Seattle are responsible for its operation and administration.

WHEREAS, King County and the City of Seattle agreed in 1951 to jointly establish and operate the Seattle-King County

Department of Public Health, and

WHEREAS, King County and the City of Seattle have operated the Department on a joint basis since 1951, and

WHEREAS, over the years, King County and the City of Seattle have worked out a process for arriving at decisions which must be made jointly, including the annual operating budget, and

WHEREAS, changes in technology and in health care expectation now require that the present administrative structure of the Health Department be examined, and

WHEREAS, King County and Seattle have accepted the responsibility for determining what changes are necessary and both local jurisdictions are participating in a study of the present arrangement, and

WHEREAS, an organization which the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare is attempting to impose on local government is proposing recommendations for operation and administration of the Health Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Council finds that operation and administration of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health are the responsibilities of the KinggCounty and the City of Seattle, pursuant to applicable state laws.
- 2. The King County Council recognizes the King County
 Health Planning Council and the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency
 in their consultative and advisory capacity, but not as having
 the legal authority to direct and regulate the operation and
 administration of the Seattle-King County Department of Health.

King County Department of Public Health.

The King County Council invites citizens interested in the Health Department to communicate with Councilmembers and to participate in public discussions and hearings when the Council is considering the Health Department's budget, administrative structure, or other relevant issues.
