

MOTION NO. 2890

1 A MOTION recognizing the 25th Day of
2 September as King County Hunting and
3 Fishing Day.

4 WHEREAS, the congestion and the complexities, the tensions
5 and frustrations of today's life, the need for outdoor recreation-
6 the opportunity to "get away from it all" - has become of crucial
7 importance, and

8 WHEREAS, there are few pursuits in King County and the State
9 of Washington providing a better chance for healthy exercise,
10 peaceful solitude, and appreciation of the great outdoors than
11 hunting and fishing, and

12 WHEREAS, King County and the State of Washington outdoor
13 sportsmen have been leaders in nearly all the major conservation
14 programs and have provided funds for fish and wildlife conserva-
15 tion and management and the propagation of vanishing species, and

16 WHEREAS, the hunters and fishermen of King County and the
17 State of Washington have made outstanding contributions to the
18 conservation, recreation and in the boating and firearm safety
19 programs, and

20 WHEREAS, the fourth Saturday of the Month of September is the
21 National Day for recognizing the American hunter and angler, and

22 WHEREAS, "Making a Good Thing Better," is the national
23 slogan during this bicentennial year for the observance;

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The King County Council hereby recognizes September 25, 1976,
26 as King County Hunting and Fishing Day and urges all King County
27 Citizens to join with sportsmen-conservationists in a rededication
28 to the wise use of our natural resources and their proper manage-
29 ment for the benefit of future generations.
