2 A MOTION OF THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL authorizing  
3 a Memorandum of Understanding with the Municipality  
4 of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO) to duly consider  
5 and implement a process to insure coordination of  
6 transportation planning activities and implementation  
7 of public transit and paratransit services.

8 WHEREAS, by virtue of their respective charter and statutory authoriza-  
9 tions, both King County and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle are  
10 engaged in various types of transportation planning which results in  
11 recommendations for maintaining and/or improving public transportation  
12 services in the metropolitan area; and

13 WHEREAS, the County and the Municipality intend from time-to-time to  
14 jointly implement such recommendations which are operationally and financially  
15 feasible and supportive of King County Transportation Goals, Objectives and  
16 Policies and the goals and objectives of the Municipality's Comprehensive Plan  
17 for Public Transportation Service; and

18 WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Administration requires that King  
19 County and the Municipality coordinate their transportation planning to ensure  
20 that such planning results in recommendations that can be implemented in a  
21 cost-effective manner; and

22 WHEREAS, the County and the Municipality desire to continue and improve  
23 coordination on inter-related transportation planning activities; and

24 WHEREAS, King County has a program wherein the analysis of community  
25 development and services, including zoning review, transportation, and  
26 issuance of Building Permits, are assessed and documented on a continuing basis  
27 as part of the King County Comprehensive Plan process and/or the Community  
28 Planning process; and

29 WHEREAS, King County has a responsibility for the planning, construction,  
30 maintenance, and operation of highways and streets together with related  
31 street furniture and other hardware; and

32 WHEREAS, METRO has the responsibility to provide public transit service(s)  
33 to the residents of King County; and

WHEREAS, it is to the mutual benefit to both King County and METRO to  
coordinate, where and whenever possible, the development, maintenance and

1 operation of the street and highway system and transit system in a manner that  
2 improves the quality and quantity of transportation services within King  
3 County.


4 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 (1) The King County Executive shall, to the extent possible, jointly  
6 implement with METRO recommendations resulting from both agencies various  
7 transportation planning activities which are financially and operationally  
8 feasible and consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, King County  
9 Community Plans and the Municipality's Comprehensive Plan for Public  
10 Transportation Service.

11 (2) The King County Executive is authorized to take such actions as may  
12 be necessary to ensure that public transportation planning of King County,  
13 funded under Section 9 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as  
14 amended, is coordinated with related transportation planning of the  
15 Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle and to take such actions, when appro-  
16 priate, to develop joint METRO/King County requests for such funds.
