MOTION NO. 2814

1
2 A MOTION approving the 1977 King County Plan
3 for Drug Abuse Services and authorizing the
4 County Executive to transmit the Plan to the
State of Washington, Department of Social and
Health Services.

5 WHEREAS, State grant-in-aid funds are provided to King
6 County to offer a meaningful program of rehabilitation for those
7 persons suffering from problems related to narcotic drugs,
8 dangerous drugs, and

9 WHEREAS, the receipt of state funds is contingent upon DSHS
10 review and approval of an annual plan of services prepared and
11 submitted by King County to the state of Washington, and

12 WHEREAS, the timely submittal of the 1977 King County Plan
13 for Drug Abuse Services to DSHS is required to insure that
14 funding to subcontracting community based organizations is not
15 impaired, and

16 WHEREAS, the use of state funds is combined with federal
17 grant-in-aid moneys to form the total amount of resources
18 allocated by King County to fund a comprehensive service network
19 to combat drug abuse problems, and

20 WHEREAS, the drug abuse program in King County is currently
21 the subject of two independent audits by both King County and
22 the federal funding source, and

23 WHEREAS, the effectiveness and cost-efficiency of the
24 present system of service delivery has been and continues to be
25 an issue of policy with the Council, and

26 WHEREAS, the use of state funds is intertwined with proposed
27 program operations which will be before the Council for review in
28 the form of the Center For Addiction Services (CAS) annual
29 refunding application to the federal government in mid-February,
30 1977, and

31 WHEREAS, information currently being prepared for Council
32 review as part of the review of the CAS annual refunding applica-
33 tion may or may not result in major revisions to the current

1 delivery of drug abuse services in King County,

2 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

3 1. Recognizing the need to comply with the administrative
4 guidelines of the State of Washington to insure that the continued
5 funding of community based programs is not impaired; the 1977
6 King County Plan for Drug Abuse Services is hereby approved by
7 the Council of King County for the purposes of submitting said
8 document to DSHS for their review and approval.

9 2. The Council reserves the right to forward the DSHS, in
10 coordination with the Executive, formal amendment to the service
11 plan based on Council policy decisions regarding review of:


12 a. The conclusions of the audit now being performed by
13 representatives of the federal funding source of the King County
14 Drug Abuse Program,

15 b. The conclusions of the audit of drug services now being
16 performed by representatives of the King County Auditor, and

17 c. The conclusions of the CAS annual refunding application
18 review by the Council, of which state funds are an integral
19 financial component.
