

MOTION NO. 2841

2 A MOTION relating to the 1977 Housing and
3 Community Development Block Grant, specifying
4 projects and allocations for the County's
5 Population Fund and transmitting projects to
6 the Joint Policy Committee for consideration
7 for Countywide Needs Funds.

8 WHEREAS, the King County urban county consortium, composed
9 of King County, twenty-six suburban cities and the Muckleshoot
10 Indian Tribe, will receive approximately \$5,452,000 for its 1977
11 Housing and Community Development Program, and

12 WHEREAS, King County will be entitled to approximately
13 \$1,942,204 in funds based upon its population, and

14 WHEREAS, King County is eligible to compete for
15 approximately \$1,553,768 in funds based upon need;

16 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

3. The Council reaffirms its intent that community centers funded through the Block Grant shall become self-supporting after two years, except that those projects first funded through the 1975 - 76 Block Grant may exclude that year, in the computation.

4. The Council intends that any other capital budget funds available for the interurban trail grant match be expended prior to Housing and Community Development Block Grant funds.

5. It is the intent of the Council that, within Project 461 King County Housing Repair Program, \$7300 be earmarked for the East Region and \$14,845 for the North Region.
