

MOTION NO: \_\_\_\_\_

A MOTION relating to land use at the central interchange sites along the Interstate 90 corridor, including the Cedar Falls, Edgewick, and South Fork interchanges.

WHEREAS, the development of the Cedar Falls, South Fork and Edgewick interchanges along the Interstate 90 corridor near North Bend will impact the town centers of Snoqualmie and North Bend, and

WHEREAS, the impacts of highway oriented uses at these interchanges need to be considered by the towns of North Bend and Snoqualmie as a consideration of their land use planning, and

WHEREAS, the Policy Development Commission has just concluded its study of these interchanges and the Planning Division has not prepared area zoning recommendations for the specific interchange sites;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

No zoning reclassifications or development plans shall be considered at the Cedar Falls, Edgewick, and South Fork Interchanges on Interstate 90, near the town of North Bend until June 1, 1977.
