A MOTION authorizing expenditure of existing funds to cover non-budgeted costs related to the conduct of a special primary and general election in the 7th Congressional District.

WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of Washington has declared April 5, 1977 and May 17, 1977 to be the dates for the Special Primary and General Elections to elect a Congressman in the Seventh Congressional District, and

WHEREAS, the King County Division of Records & Elections is vested with the responsibility for conducting said elections, and

WHEREAS, the 1977 Budget for the Division of Records and Elections does not contain funds for said elections,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Manager of Records & Elections is hereby authorized to incur expenses with existing budgeted funds to conduct and support said elections. When exact expenditures are known, the Division can request an additional appropriation of funds to cover all related expenses.
