A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to request a 312 Rehabilitation Loan Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, King County has already made a substantial commitment to housing repair and rehabilitation through its Block Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the public policy of the County is that citizens have safe and sanitary housing, and

WHEREAS, some of the housing stock of the County is deteriorated and blighted, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development administers a national program through which low interest loans are made available for the repair and rehabilitation of homes and certain multiple dwelling units,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to notify the Department of Housing and Urban Development of the County's desire to participate in the rehabilitation loan program authorized by Section 312 of the Housing Act of 1964, to provide HUD with the necessary preliminary information, and to prepare detailed implementing ordinances and budget requests for consideration by the Council if HUD should formally offer the program to King County.
