2 A MOTION approving and authorizing procedures
3 and processes to be administered by the
4 Executive in allocating CETA funds awarded to
5 King County for job creation, as part of the
6 national economic stimulus package, proposed
7 by the federal government.

8 WHEREAS, the national administration has proposed a \$31.2
9 billion budgetary package to positively stimulate the national
10 economy, and

11 WHEREAS, approval of the administration's economic stimulus
12 program by Congress is anticipated in the near future, and

13 WHEREAS, an integral component of the administration's
14 recovery program is to expend public funds through the
15 Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 to immediately
16 create public service employment positions to impact the high
17 national unemployment levels, and

18 WHEREAS, the Department of Labor, in anticipation of
19 implementing an extensive expansion of the CETA program
20 nationally, has directed the CETA prime program sponsors to plan
21 and implement an allocation process in advance of the award of
22 CETA funds, so as to implement public service jobs as quickly as
23 feasible, and

24 WHEREAS, King County as well as other major units of
25 government are participating members and program agents of the
26 King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium (KSMC), and

27 WHEREAS, King County as well as other major units of
28 government have proposed an allocation process for CETA funds to
29 be distributed as part of the administration's economic recovery
30 program, and

31 WHEREAS, the allocation process conforms with required
32 federal legislation, rules and regulations and allows the
33 flexibility for each unit of participating government to expend
34 funds to service priority public service needs, and

35 WHEREAS, the executive committee of KSMC, composed of the

1 elected officials of each participating jurisdiction, have
2 proposed and approved general time frames of activities to
3 complete the proposed CETA allocation process in an expeditious
4 manner, and

5 WHEREAS, the approval of the proposed allocation process by
6 the legislative bodies of each jurisdiction is required, and


7 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council, in coordination
8 with the administrative processes of the Executive, to adhere to
9 previously proposed time frames approved by the executive
10 committee of KSMC in planning, implementing, and awarding CETA
11 funds to eligible applicants,

12 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


13 The proposed allocation process for CETA Title VI
14 funds awarded by the Department of Labor through the King-
15 Snohomish Manpower Consortium to King County as part of the
16 federal government's economic recovery program is hereby approved;
17 PROVIDED THAT, the Executive is authorized to implement
18 administrative procedures and processes in coordination with KSMC
19 to accomplish the allocation process of CETA funds, as proposed
20 in the Public Service Projects Selection Process, as approved by
21 the Council and the executive committee of the King-Snohomish
22 Manpower Consortium.
