PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE KING-SNOHOMISH MANPOWER CONSORTIUM INTERLOCAL GOVERNMENT AGREEMENT

The language in Paragraph (2), page 2, of Appendix I to the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium Interlocal Government Agreement, which was duly executed on the 29th day of August, 1975, shall be amended to read as follows:

(2) That all grant agreements between the Consortium and the United States Department of Labor shall be signed by the Chairperson of the Executive Committee of the Consortium, who shall be the chief executive officer of one of the members of the Consortium; Provided that, in the absence of the Chairperson, said grant agreements shall be signed by the Deputy Chairperson of the Executive Committee of the Consortium, who shall be the chief executive officer of one of the members of the Consortium.

All other provisions of Appendix I shall remain in full force and effect as written.

This amendment is executed pursuant to the provision for amending the Interlocal Government Agreement adopted May 23, 1973, and shall have full force and effect from and after January 1, 1977, irrespective of the date of execution.
